**Show Table Conditions:**

- 1) All products for the sales table to be supplied on a sale or return basis.
- 2) Honey will be sold at £6.00 for a 16oz jar, £5.00 12oz jar, £4.00 8oz jar, and Cut Comb £6.50 for 8oz.

Other hive products as priced and 20% of the sale price of all products will be retained by SBKA with the supplier receiving 80% of the selling price of all sold items.

- 3) All jars of honey offered for sale must be labelled in accordance with the current regulations. The SBKA reserve the right to decline any jars that do not meet this condition.

- 3) Beekeepers who want to sell their hive products must have at least one entry in the Honey Show.

- 4) Delivery required to the Suffolk Beekeeper's Marquee on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2018.

Note: For those who are not going or find it difficult to deliver to the Showground your products can be left with your local branch Show Representative. Please contact your branch secretary for further details.
